This has been an incredible experience, which began with an Agent Audition at Showbiz Kids and Teens last Fall. Although we don't know what the future holds, the possibilities are very exciting. I strongly encourage every talented student at Showbiz Kids and Teens to work hard, train with the best and know that dreams can come true. Training and exposure and the right connections is the most important element. Words that we have learned to live by:

\* Network – go on as many auditions as possible. One connection always leads to the next connection.

\* Flexibility – when you first get started please know that as talented as your child may be, there is another one just as talented or if not more so. You must be flexible and literally go where you are told to go and jump when you are told to jump.

\* Patience – schedules get changed constantly. Do not get frustrated.

\* Money – yup that is right cash! For Actors – you should never pay an agent BUT there are costs such as professional head shots, model reels and possible travel. For singers, record labels are not interested in Karaoke singers. You MUST have original music. Record labels no longer develop talent. A songwriter/producer and studio may be costly

As a single parent, this journey has been very scary. Time, money and resources are very scarce – but I don't regret any investment for one second. I believe in my child and whatever happens I am proud of her.

### ARTS SCHOOLS AUDITION PREPARATION

Each year Showbiz Kids and Teens conducts a workshop which helps prepares our clients for the mandatory audition at the Bak Middle School and Dreyfoos School of the Arts. This workshop gives our clients the edge when auditioning for these schools Mr. Leeds works with each student individually to help them deliver a monologue with passion and professionalism. This intensive 5 week workshop will begin November 15th 2010 and end on December 13th from 5 to 630 pm . Sessions are 1 1/2 hours each.

If you sign up for this important workshop, it is your responsibility to pick up the requirements for the Theatre Program at the school you are applying to. Enrollment fee is \$125 for the five sessions. Deadline to sign is October 30th. Fees are due by the deadline and is non refundable It will be your responsibility to have your monologue choice memorized by the first day of the workshop. Please make sure you check with the school to ensure you have the require Monologue for the Audition.
